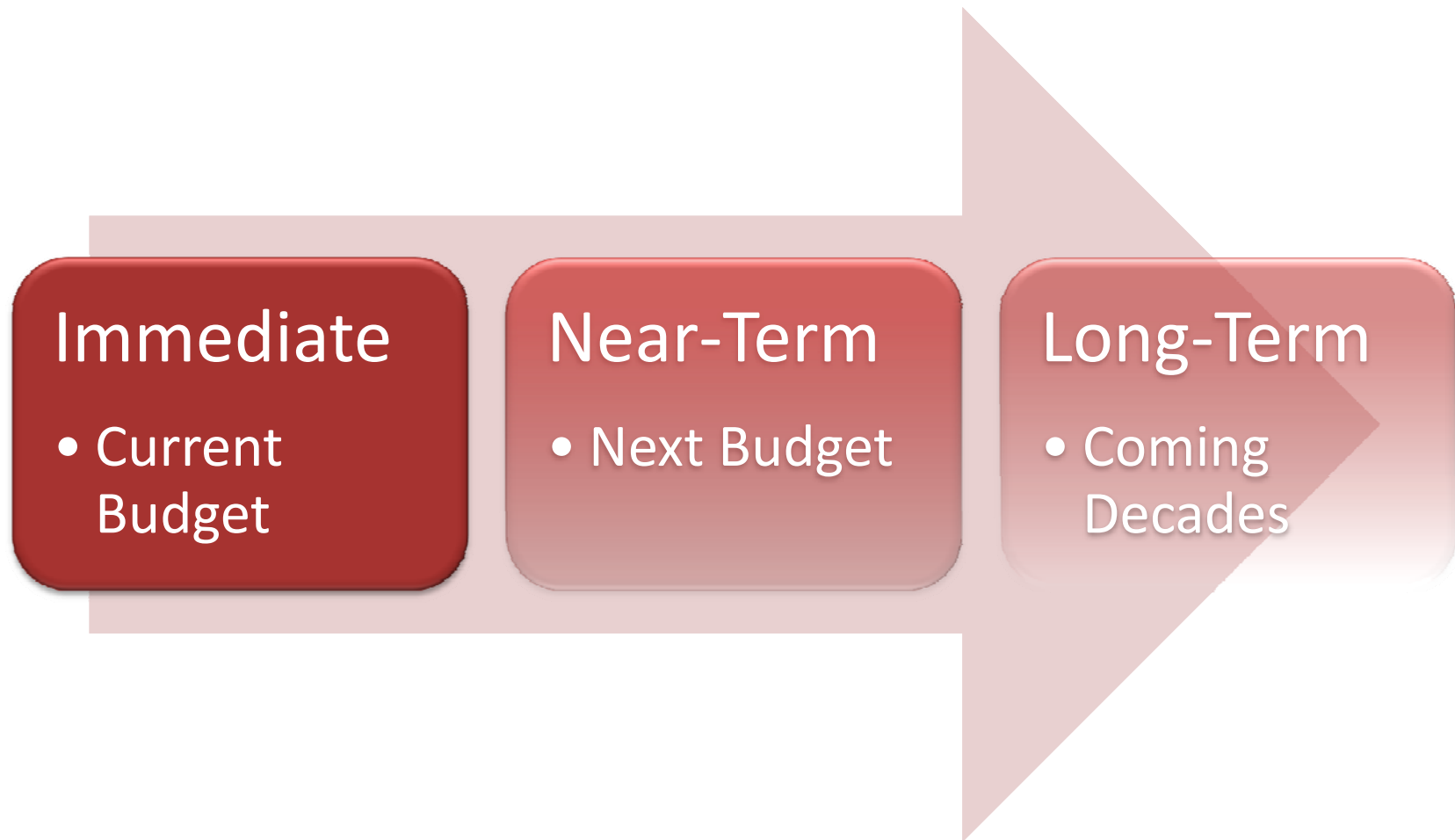

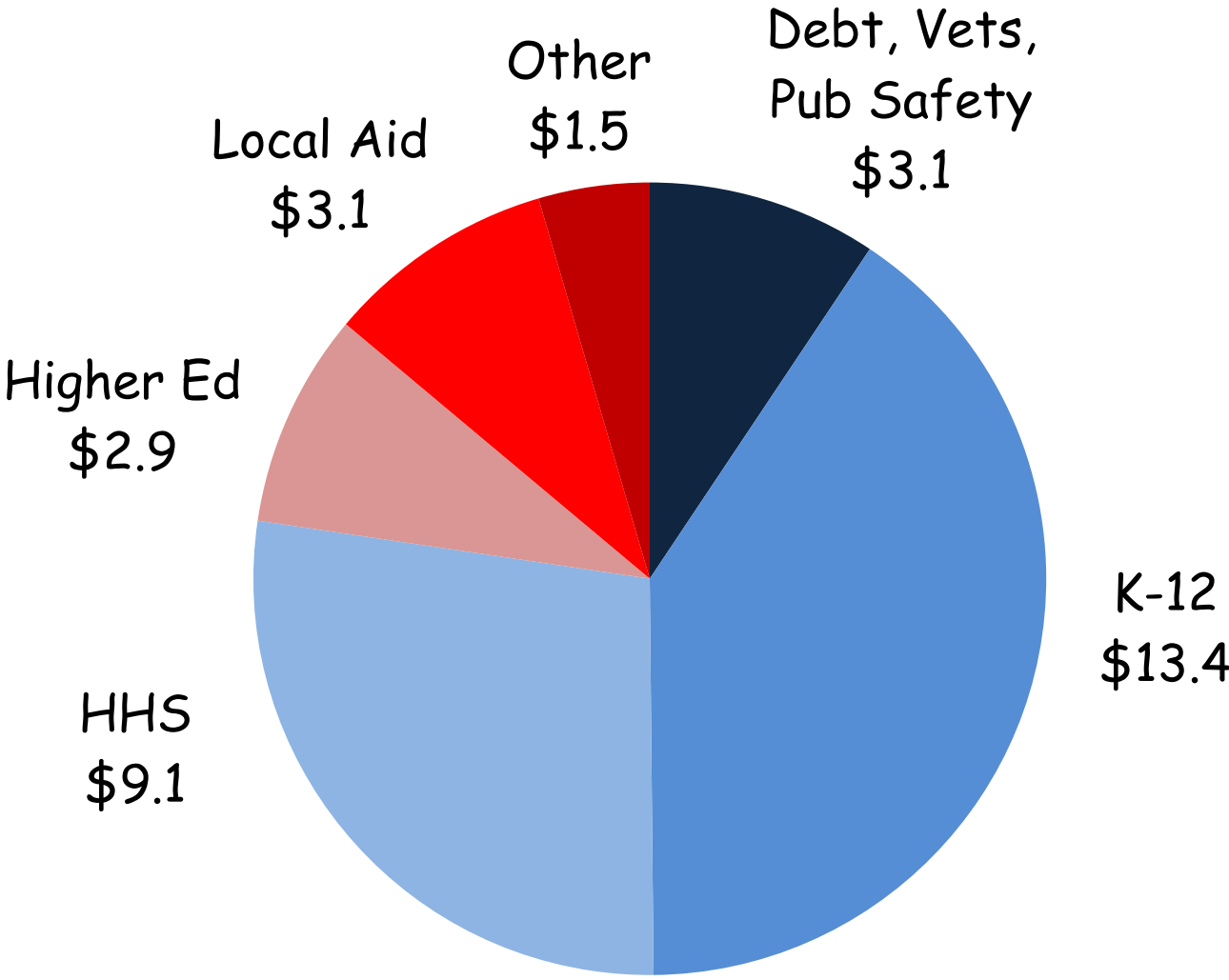

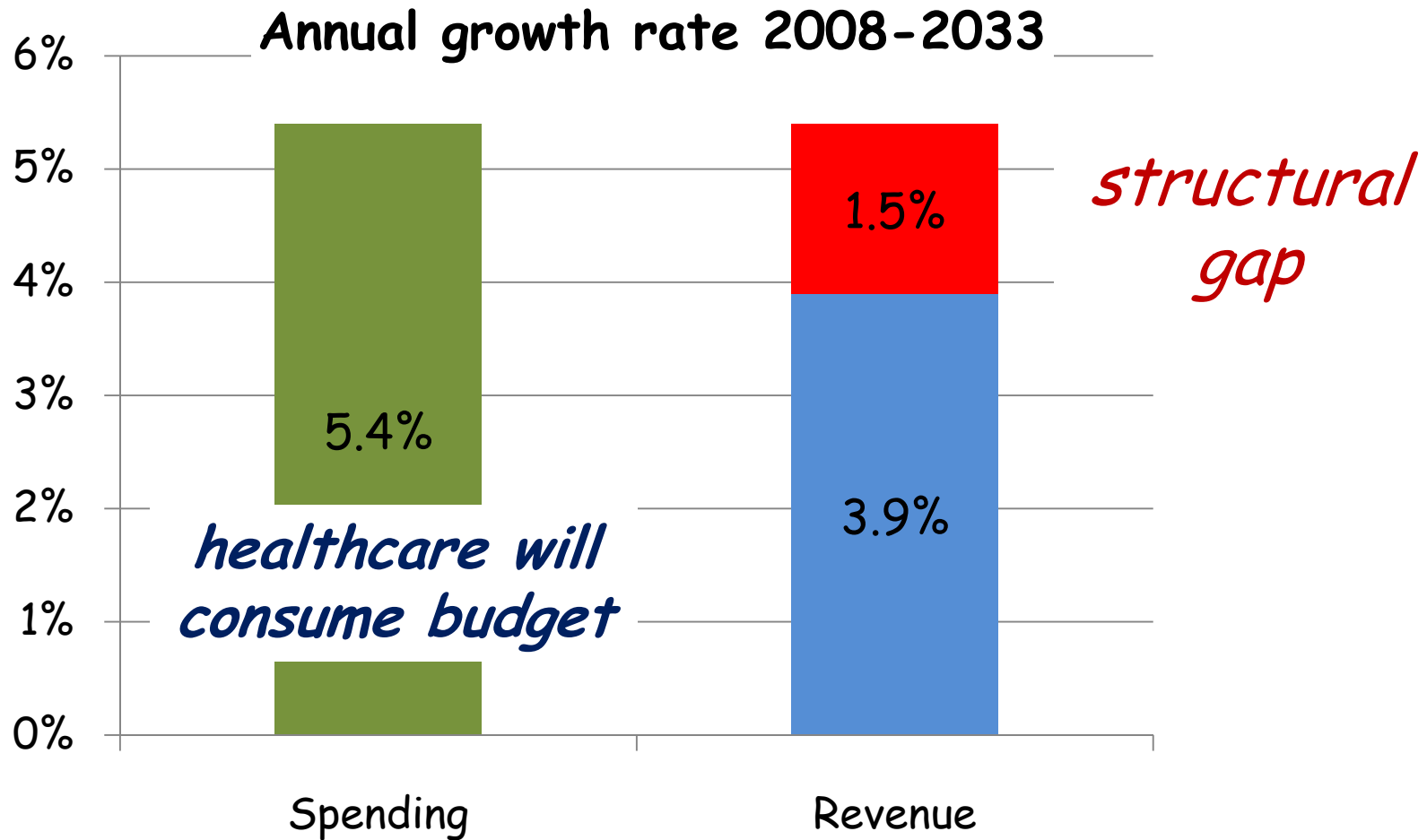

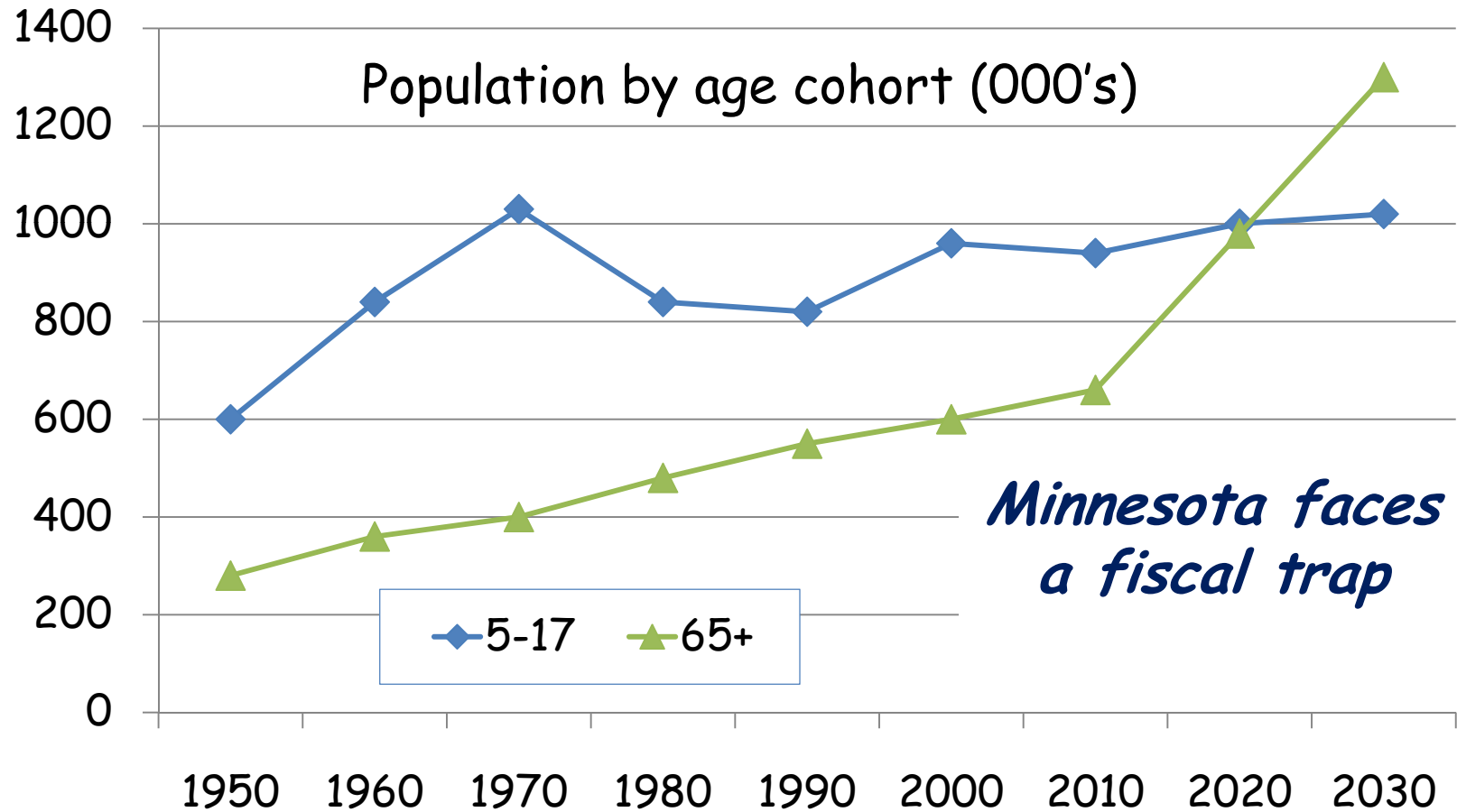

1. Balance budget for long-term
 - ✓ ongoing structural balance
2. Reform major cost drivers
 - ✓ healthcare, long-term care
3. Invest in productivity
 - ✓ public infrastructure & education
 - ✓ incent private investment
